
The Dental Hygiene Department at Farmingdale State College is holding their tenth annual Give Kids a Smile event on Friday February 2, 2018, with a snow date of February 9, 2018. Our Give Kids a Smile is an annual centerpiece to National Children's Dental Health Month. It is a one-day free event where oral health care providers volunteer their time to provide free dental services to underserved children in the surrounding communities.

The purpose of the event is to focus attention on the epidemic of untreated oral disease among disadvantaged children by providing free dental cleanings, oral screenings, fluoride treatments, oral health education and dental sealants if the oral health care provider deems it necessary. All treatment provided at the center is supervised by faculty registered dental hygienists and dentists employed by Farmingdale State College as well as dentists from the Suffolk County Dental Society and dental residents from Stony Brook University.

There are many children in the surrounding communities that can benefit from this free event. Please distribute the enclosed flyer to the children in the district to afford them the opportunity to attend this free annual event. Each child will be given an absenteeism note at the conclusion of their oral health visit to submit to their appropriate school district.
