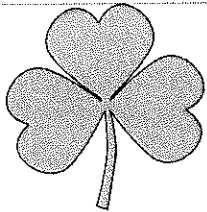


Congratulations to our many talented students!

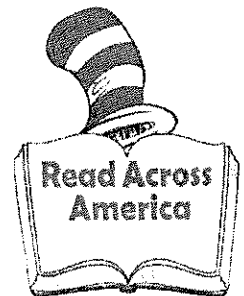
